Parent/Doctor Request for Medication Administration

According to the guide for School Nursing Services in Pennsylvania, no medication should be administered in school except by the direct order of physician. KCSD requires physician authorization for administration of all prescription medication. With request from a parent, a non-prescription medication can be given at school for a period of 5 consecutive days. For long-term administration of a non-prescription medication, physician authorization is also required.
